Student Contest Announcement

CCWSA is conducting a photography contest in which the photograph depicts the “Beauty Of Our Water Resources”. The contest is open to all Cherokee County students K-12 (including home school students).

The Etowah River is the source of the quality drinking water provided to CCWSA customers. Photographs must be taken within the Upper Etowah River Watershed (*see map below*). Photographs including people enjoying our water resources or wildlife (*above or underwater*) that depend on our water resources are examples that would depict this year’s theme.

- Photograph must be **original** and **taken by the student**.
- All entries must be in digital format. Digital effects and collages created by the student are permitted.
- Photo entries must include a **Picture Title, Student’s Name, School, Grade**, and an **Explanation (50 words or less)** of where/when the photograph was taken and what that water source means to you. Pictures without a title and/or the explanation will be disqualified. If faces are recognizable in the photo, a signed release form must accompany the photo. A photo release will be e-mailed to participants upon request.

Deadline For Contest Entries Is December 18th, 2015
There will be a K – 6th Grade Winner and a 7th – 12th Grade Winner.

The winning photographs will be replicated and framed for display in the entrance of the CCWSA Main Office, and at the following CCWSA facilities: the Environmental Affairs office, the Rose Creek WRF, the Fitzgerald Creek WRF, the Etowah River WTF, and H. Q. Lathem Reservoir for one year.

The winning entries will receive a **\$50** prize, as well as one framed 8 x 10 of their winning photo.
