BOIL WATER NOTICE

January 28, 2012

The Cherokee County Water and Sewerage Authority advises residents, of a limited portion of the Toonigh Community, of a boil water notice, effective immediately. **This notice ONLY affects residents along Toonigh Road, from the intersection of Springwater Trace to Old Magnolia Trail. Approximately 175 homes are affected, including homes in the Valley Brook subdivision.** Water should be boiled prior to consumption for at least one minute after reaching a rolling boil. Citizens, within this specific area, should continue to boil their water until the boil water notice is lifted. The boil water notice is due to a water main break near Toonigh Road and Springfield Place in which water had to be valved off until the repairs are completed. When this occurs a potential health hazard may exist in these areas of zero pressure from backflow and/or back-siphonage of water of unknown quality into the water distribution system. **Laboratory Samples are currently being taken. Once laboratory tests have been completed and confirmed safe for human consumption, the boil water notice will be lifted. Once again, This notice ONLY affects residents along Toonigh Road, from the intersection of Springwater Trace to Old Magnolia Trail. Approximately 175 homes are affected, including homes in the Valley Brook subdivision.**
